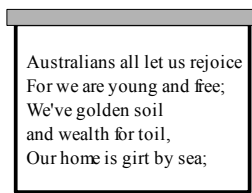

Projector Presentation Tips.

When it comes to projecting words for a song at your place of worship or statistics in a powerpoint presentation it is very important the whole audience can see it clearly. The following information sheet will show you how to get the best results from your installed system.

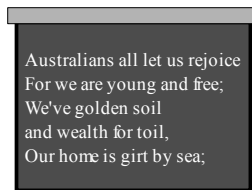
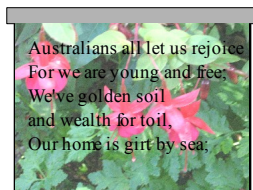


✔ Use large Fonts – 25PT or above.

✔ Use high contrast colours for text and backgrounds. White text with Black background normally works best.

✔ Have minimal lines of text on the screen. - No more that 4 or 5.

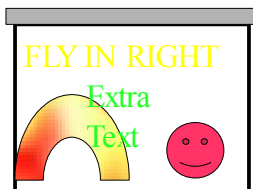
✔ Avoid using pictures as background behind text.



✔ Avoid using fly in effects and pattens.

✔ Only display the text and information that is necessary for the presentation.

✔ Always ensure that your Projector is in focus and has a clean lens.



It is important to remember how you require the projected image to enhance your church service or presentation without being a distraction or something which doesn't add to the service. You must also be aware of changing the slides or presentation during the service. Most projectors will include a mute feature which will enable this to be achieved cleanly.

Connecting a Laptop to Data Projector Using VGA

When connecting your laptop computer to a Data Projector using the blue VGA cable, you may at times need to manually output the signal to the Data Projector. Using a PC laptop you will need to press and hold down the FN Key with the associated function key until the image is displayed. The Function key for this varies from different laptop manufacturers. Commonly there will be either the text LCD/CRT or two picture of different screens for the button which you need to press.
